ABOUT THE SPEAKER

Jennifer Choe Groves is Senior Director for Intellectual Property and Innovation and the Chair of the Special 301 Committee in the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR). Ms. Choe Groves chairs the interagency government committee that conducts the annual Special 301 review, which examines the degree to which countries provide adequate and effective protection of intellectual property. She was the primary author of the Special 301 Reports issued by the Administration in 2005 to 2009. In addition, Ms. Choe Groves is the lead intellectual property negotiator in numerous Free Trade Agreements with international trading partners.

Ms. Choe Groves began her legal career as a prosecutor with the Manhattan District Attorney's Office. She subsequently entered private practice with several prominent law firms, where she practiced intellectual property and entertainment litigation. Ms. Choe Groves has published numerous articles and has spoken extensively on intellectual property and entertainment law.

Ms. Choe Groves received an LL.M. from Columbia University Law School, a J.D. from Rutgers Law School, and an A.B. from Princeton University. She is also a graduate of the Juilliard School of Music, where she studied piano and composition.
