## Music in the New Millenium

By the close of 1999, as the music industry was dealing with Napster, Grokster, and iTunes, you couldn't yet buy ringtones for your cellphone but you could buy your CD's and LP's from Tower Records. Now less than ten years later, the music industry hardly resembles its recent past. The PNW Chapter of the U.S. Copyright Society looks at music copyright issues, the state of the music industry today, and the adequacy of current copyright law's protections, exceptions, and relevance to today's industry and tomorrow's innovations. The stellar panel of industry veterans includes:

### **Dave Dederer**

Best-known as founding member, guitarist, singer, songwriter and producer with the two-time Grammy-nominated, multi-platinum band **The Presidents of the United States of America**, Dederer is a seasoned business professional, managing the business of the band and currently serving as Vice President, Media Content with Melodeo, a Seattle mobile media software company. Dederer sits on the boards of The Pacific Northwest Chapter of The Recording Academy (the Grammy's) and One Reel (Bumbershoot/WAMU Family Fourth/Teatro Zinzanni parent organization). A graduate of Brown University, Dederer also completed all studies for a Master's in Urban Planning at the University of Washington before unexpected rock stardom derailed his thesis.

### **Robert Sullivan**

A partner in the Nashville Office of Loeb & Loeb, Bob represents major recording artists, producers, and songwriters, including **Randy Travis** and **Johnny Cash**. Bob's practice focuses on entertainment transactions primarily in the music field, as well as litigation and mediation in entertainment and intellectual property areas. His well known successful cases include the Bridgeport Music copyright infringement cases, and defending Joe Diffie in the trial and appeal of a copyright infringement action for " Prop Me Up Beside the Juke Box" and Randy Travis in the case involving "Better Class of Losers". A *magna cum laude* graduate of Vanderbilt University, Bob has J.D. from Vanderbilt Law School, teaches at the Nashville School of Law and Belmont College, and is listed in "Best Lawyers in America" in the field of Entertainment Law.

### **Dan Sheeran**

Dan Sheeran is SVP of Business Development and Corporate Partnerships for Real Networks, which has pioneered platforms for delivering digital media and letting consumers enjoy digital music across the Internet. Since joining RealNetworks in 2001, Dan has held a variety of senior positions, including SVP of Music and Video, SVP of International, and SVP of Marketing. Prior to RealNetworks, Dan served as SVP of Sales and Marketing for nCUBE, a provider of advertising management and interactive television systems for the cable television industry. Dan received a U.S. patent for an invention related to increasing the capacity of cable TV systems to carry Internet traffic. Dan holds a B.S. from Georgetown University, and M.B.A. from Northwestern University.
