Ralph served as the Register of Copyrights, the chief government official charged with administering copyright law, from 1985 to 1993, and thus brings unique insight to the legislative process and the inner workings of the Copyright Office. Currently he is Counsel in Dechert LLP's Washington, D.C. Office, and recently he was selected "Best Lawyer in Washington DC" by the Washington Post Magazine.
