

Jason Mazzone, Brooklyn Law School

Jason Mazzone is Associate Professor of Law at Brooklyn Law School. He teaches courses in Constitutional Law, American Legal History, and Intellectual Property. His book, *Copyfraud and Other Abuses of Intellectual Property* will be published in 2010 by Stanford University Press. Professor Mazzone is a graduate of Harvard College and Harvard Law School and he received his doctorate from Yale University. Before entering academia he was a law clerk to Judge Robert D. Sack, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, and then to Judge John G. Koeltl, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York.
