June M. Besek is the Executive Director of the Kernochan Center for Law, Media and the Arts at Columbia Law School. She heads the Kernochan Center's program for intellectual property studies and law reform, which is currently involved in a number of projects relating to digital libraries and archives. She also teaches a seminar on Advanced Topics in Copyright with Professor Jane Ginsburg, and a seminar on Authors, Artists and Performers.

Ms. Besek serves as a member of the Section 108 Study Group, created by the Library of Congress and the Copyright Office to examine the exceptions for libraries and archives in the Copyright Act and to make recommendations for legislative change in light of new technologies. She is a member of Council for the ABA Intellectual Property Section, and a former chair of the Copyright Division. She serves on the editorial board of the *Journal of the Copyright Society of the U.S.A.* and the board of advisors of the *Columbia Journal of Law & the Arts*. She is also a member of the Committee on Entertainment Law of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York.
