

## **Susan Scafidi**

Susan Scafidi is the first U.S. law professor ever to offer a course in Fashion Law, and she has testified in Congress regarding the proposed Design Piracy Prohibition Act. Her areas of expertise include intellectual property and cultural property, and she is currently a visiting professor at Fordham Law School as well as a tenured member of both the law and history faculties at SMU. She has also taught at a number of other law schools, including most recently Yale and Georgetown. After attending Duke University and the Yale Law School, she pursued graduate study in legal history at Berkeley and the University of Chicago and clerked for Judge Morris S. Arnold of the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals. Professor Scafidi is the author of *Who Owns Culture? Appropriation and Authenticity in American Law* (2005) and also writes a blog on fashion and intellectual property, [Counterfeit Chic](#).
